

**Corrado Viafora** is Full Professor of Moral Philosophy and Bioethics at the Department of Molecular Medicine, University of Padova (Italy), where he is also Director of an Advanced Course in Bioethics. Professor Viafora was the scientific coordinator of the Padova period of the *Erasmus Mundus Master of Bioethics* (2006-2016). His main research interests include: human dignity and bioethics; theoretical models in clinical bioethics; ethics of palliative care; ethics of neonatal intensive care; bioethics education.

He is author and editor of more than 20 books, among which *Clinical Bioethics. A Search for the Foundations* (Dordrecht, 2005) and *A lezione di bioetica. Temi e strumenti* (Milano, 2015<sup>2</sup>). He is Editor of the book series “Studi e ricerche di bioetica e scienze umane” and member of the Editorial Board of “Bioethics UPdate”.
